Getting Started

Before you Begin

- Go alone or with a few others, not in large groups.
- Choose your area and whether you will walk, bike or drive.
- Pray that God will give you divine insights and connect you with the right people.

During your walk

- Walk naturally, with your eyes open as you pray. Speak as if you were having a conversation with a friend.
- Observe the people, buildings, and signs around you. Ask God to show you what he sees in them.
- Go into shops and talk to the owners. Ask about the needs of the community. If there is an opening, offer to pray for the people you meet.

Ideas for what to pray

- Ask God questions about the things you observe. Wait in silence for him to answer. Pray scriptures.
- Read a few verses, then stop and pray in that vein.
- Pray for healing and freedom.
- Pray for God to bless leaders and give them wisdom.
- Ask God to reveal creative ways to connect with people and draw them into spiritual conversations.
